### **Tournament Structure**

### **Teams:** Each team consists of 2 players.

Match Format: Matches are played over 9 holes.

# **Time Limit:** Each match has a maximum duration of 1.5 hours.

In this format, two teams of two players each compete following Match Play and Scramble rules. Both players on a team participate in every shot, starting with both hitting from the tee. The team then selects the best shot and continues by playing their next shots from that location. This process repeats until they successfully hole out.

Finals: Best 4 Teams Advance





## **Gameplay Rules**

**Tee Times:** Teams must arrive 15 minutes before their scheduled match time for check in.

**Equipment:** Players must use their own golf clubs and equipment.

**Conduct:** Players are expected to maintain sportsmanship and respect for other participants and staff.

**Scoring:** Standard golf scoring rules apply. The team with the lowest combined score wins the match.

**Ties:** In case of a tie, a sudden death playoff on a designated hole will determine the winner.

**Finals**: Best 4 Teams from Round 1 (Fri/Sat) Advance.





### **Course Rules**

Virtual Environment: Follow the virtual course guidelines as provided by the simulator.

**Out of Bounds**: Standard out of bounds rules apply as per the virtual course settings.

**Hazards:** Virtual hazards such as water and sand traps must be played as per standard golf rules.







### **Dress Code**

Golf attire is encouraged. Athletic wear is acceptable.

No inappropriate clothing.

Footwear: Golf shoes or athletic shoes are encouraged. No cleats or spikes.





### **Behavior and Etiquette**

**Respect:** Treat all participants, staff, and equipment with respect.

**Noise:** Maintain a reasonable noise level. Avoid distractions to other players.

**Safety:** Follow all safety guidelines provided by Pla-Mor Entertainment.





### **Disputes and Decisions**

**Rules Disputes:** Vicente Pena, as the golf expert (Tournament Marshal), will have the final say in any rules disputes.

**Conduct Violations:** Any violation of the rules or inappropriate behavior may result in disqualification.
